Amid all the gloomy news we have been enduring these past several months we have some very good news. We are pleased to announce we will resume gathering for worship on Sunday July 12th.

When we come together for services on that Sunday, there will be modifications to the order of worship, but the liturgy of Word and Sacrament will be the same.

Attendance at each service **limited to 35 persons** in the pavilion and 45 in the church. **Advance reservations will be necessary for each person coming to worship.** Reservations can be made *online via Realm* or by phone to the church office at 610-253-1625.

Much of our building will remain **off limits** and entering the building will be done by the **front door only**.

Offerings will not be collected during the services but may be placed in the plate near the sanctuary entrance or by using Realm.

Communion will be offered at both services for those that feel comfortable receiving the Lord's Supper. Individual settings (as shown in the pictures) will be distributed to the congregants while they remain seated. The settings are prepackaged and are disposable so that handling is kept to a minimum. Gluten free and juice options are available upon request, but please notify an elder before service.

Let us rejoice that we now have opportunity to gather together in the presence of God through His Word and Sacraments for receiving His divine gifts of forgiveness, life, and salvation! Though the earth be in turmoil in many diverse ways, our Lord remains the same, yesterday, today, and forever! Let us rejoice and be glad in Him!
